



**Consulate General of the Republic of Suriname
in Amsterdam**

Tourist visa for Suriname

Applicant is not an EU citizen, does not reside in the EU, there is no diplomatic or consular mission in the country of residence.

Visa documents	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A copy of the application form duly completed online and signed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A separate form for minors (under 18 years) signed by the parent(s)/legal guardian + official documents proving parental authority/legal guardianship (birth certificate, etc.) 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A color passport size picture <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not older than 6 months - Not older than 3 months for children under 6 years. - Specifications : professional quality, facing camera directly, neutral expression, mouth closed 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Original passport <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Passport should not be less than 6 months valid on arrival in Suriname - The passport should have a least one page which is empty on both sides. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Original residence permit, if applicable (or copy front/back) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The residence permit should not be less than 3 months valid on arrival in Suriname. <p><i>Note: proof of valid Schengen visa, UK visa, US visa, etc. recommendable</i></p> 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Proof of sufficient financial means <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If applicable, bank statements showing applicant's name, proof of salary, pension, etc. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Flight ticket/reservation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A copy of the e-ticket(s) showing entry and departure within 90 days (for persons of non-Surinamese origin). 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Host/sponsor/hotel reservation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Host/sponsor: full name, complete address and contact information must be typed into the online visa form - Hotel accommodation: a copy of the confirmed hotel reservation - Renting an apartment: a copy of the contract - Own house: copy of the deed 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Vaccinations <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If applicable, certificate of valid yellow fever vaccination - Health certificates 	

Please note:

- The Consulate will communicate in Dutch or English
- Documentation should – if necessary – be submitted with an official translation in the Dutch or English language
- Only complete applications will be taken into consideration
- Alternatives of supporting documents should be accompanied by an explanation
- On the basis of an interview additional information/documents not mentioned above may be required.

Online visa form:

When filling in the online visa form, please take the following into account:

- a social security number is not mandatory
- Disregard the “visa card” page (step 4) completely and proceed to the next step
- the visa fees mentioned in the visa form are not valid any more
- if your travel agent is not listed, click on the term “losse aanvraag” in the list.
- The visa form cannot be completed earlier than 2 months before the departure date

Types of tourist visas:

- Tourist visa (single entry) : 40 euro
- Tourist visa (multiple entries within 2 months): 40 euro
- Tourist visa (multiple entries within 1 year): 150 euro

Maximum stay: 90 days for persons of non-Surinamese origin

Payments to the bank account of the Consulate should **only be made after alignment** with the Visa department, see bank information.

How to submit a visa application

A.	In person/by a third party at the Visa office of the Consulate of Suriname in Amsterdam. Monday – Friday, 09.00– 14.00 h. Address: De Cuserstraat 11, 1081 CK, Amsterdam Complete visa applications can be processed in <u>one day</u> , provided there are no objections.
B.	By registered mail of courier (see our website information)
C.	Only for non EU applicants who reside outside of the EU where there is no diplomatic or consular mission of Suriname Visa advise should be obtained in advance by sending a <u>copy</u> of the relevant visa documents by email to the Consulate not earlier than 2 months before the intended departure date. The visa advise request to consul.netherlands@foreignaffairs.gov.sr should be <u>limited to 1 (one) email message</u> with a maximum of 10 pages (attachments) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The Consulate will reply/acknowledge receipt within 10 days- A decision will follow after at least 15 working days. In case of a favorable consideration the original passport + all original visa documents must be submitted at the Consulate in Amsterdam in a timely manner, as mentioned in A or B.
